


CORRUPTION PERCEPTIONS **INDEX 2019**







POLITICAL INTEGRITY

Keeping big money out of politics is essential to ensure political decision-making serves the public interest and curb opportunities for corrupt deals.

TRANSPARENCY IN **CAMPAIGN FINANCE**

Countries that perform well on the CPI have strong enforcement of campaign finance regulations.




- VARIETIES OF DEMOCRACY (V-DEM) 2019 "DISCLOSURE OF CAMPAIGN DONATIONS" -

Greater transparency of campaign donations is associated with lower levels of corruption. Each dot represents a country's CPI 2019 score and the circles represent the average CPI score as compared to the strength of enforcement.

POLITICAL **DECISION-MAKING**

Countries that **perform well** on the CPI have broader consultation in policy decisions.



VARIETIES OF DEMOCRACY (V-DEM) 2019 "RANGE OF CONSULTATION" ----

Broad consultation in political decision-making is associated with lower levels of corruption. Each dot represents a country's CPI 2019 score and the circles represent the average CPI score as compared to the extent of consultation.


